ACQ Quilt Show Entry Rules

Entry Rules:

- A. Only current ACQ members may enter their work. Yearly ACQ dues are \$25.00.
- B. Entries in categories 100 thru 500 must be the work of at least one ACQ member. Entries in categories 600 thru 1400 must be the work of only one person, an ACQ member.
- C. A member may submit a maximum of two quilts (one quilt per category except Display Only).
- D. Each entry may be entered into only ONE category.
- E. A quilt must consist of three layers: top, batting and backing and be quilted by hand, machine or a combination of both. No tied comforters will be accepted. Quilts should not be framed with wood, metal, etc.
- F. No entries from previous ACQ Quilt shows.
- G. Entries must have been completed after January 1, 2008.
- H. Entries must be finished, clean and in good condition.
- I. The ACQ Quilt Show committee reserves the right to disqualify any entry and will decide how to display the entries.
- J. Quilts must have a 4" finished sleeve sewn to the top edge of the back of the quilt for hanging.
- K. Each quilt is to be received in its own cloth bag or pillowcase. Both the quilt and cloth bag must have a permanent label with the entrant's name and name of quilt. Please cover the maker's name on the quilt label with fabric attached by safety pins.
- L. Entry Form MUST be received by APRIL 8, 2010. For each item entered (maximum of two) send a completed entry form and \$15.00 entry fee (\$10.00 if returned by March ACQ meeting), payable to ACQ, to Ann Petersen, 12799 E. Vassar Dr., Aurora, CO 80014.

Timetable:

- O. April 8, 2010: Completed entry form and \$15.00 check (\$10.00 if returned by March 11, 2010), payable to ACQ for each entry (Maximum of 2) received by Ann Petersen
- P. May 24– June 5, 2010: Drop off entries at Great American Quilt Factory, Fabric Expressions, or High Prairie Quilts.
- Q. June 7, 2010, 4:00-7:00 PM: Entries accepted at the show site. No entries accepted after this date.
- R. June 8, 2010: Judge show and start hanging show.
- S. June 9, 2010: Hang show and Reception for entrants.
- T. June 10 – 12 2010: Show open to public.
- U. June 12, 2010, 5:00 – 6:00 PM: Pick up entries at the show site. Written authorization is required for someone else to pick up your quilt.
- V. If no description is provided, only your name and name of entry will appear for viewer information on the printed program.

- W. In the event of a large or small number of entries in a given category, the committee reserves the right to further subdivide or combine categories.
- X. Insurance: Entrant is responsible for insurance and Must sign the release on the Entry Form.
- Y. June 2010 CQC Quilt Colorado – ACQ will deliver your quilt to Quilt Colorado IF you circle YES on the CQC question on the Entry Form and if your quilt is accepted by Quilt Colorado, please let Ann Petersen know before June 12, 2010 at 5:00 PM.

Category Definitions:

Display Only – Displayed, but not judged, in this category only.

Judged Categories

Group Quilts – Quilts made by two or more people. This includes quilt tops made by two or more people OR quilt tops made by one person AND quilted by hand or machine (including long arm) by another person or organization.

Kit or Block-of the Month – Quilt made from a preplanned commercial kit or block-of-the-month club, where a shop or other design source has supplied the pattern and fabric, may be long arm quilted. Must supply design source.

Machine Quilted – Quilt that was machine quilted (may have some hand quilting). May be quilted on a domestic or a long arm machine.

Hand Quilted – Quilt that is entirely hand quilted.

Large Quilt – Quilt with a perimeter greater than 280"

Small Quilt – Quilt with a perimeter equal to or less than 280"

Mixed/Other Surface – Quilt with equal amounts of piecing and appliqué, whole cloth quilt, or other techniques such as embroidery, fabric paint, photo transfers, embellishment, etc

Art Quilt – Quilt of original design that evokes or explores emotions through innovative themes, materials or construction.

500 Kit or Block-of-the-Month Quilts

700 Large Quilts – Mostly appliquéd- Machine quilted

800 Large Quilts – Mixed/Other-Machine quilted

900 Large Quilts – Hand quilted – Any technique

1000 Small Quilts – Mostly pieced – Machine quilted

1100 Small Quilts – Mostly appliquéd – Machine quilted

1200 Small Quilts – Mixed/Other – Machine quilted

1300 Small Quilts – Hand quilted – Any technique
