Terribly Terrific Techniques Workshop

Kelly is a trained and experienced judge, curator of the Hoffman Challenge, and a prolific quilter and designer for the quilt market. Many quilts she makes are done on extremely short deadlines. She has learned and adopted many techniques (and uses indispensable tools and supplies) for speed and accuracy that don't compromise quality workmanship. This class will show you substitute methods for many difficult techniques, and help you correct the most common errors that judges note in competition. This class is perfect for a newer or beginner quilter, but even super experienced quilters will learn a great deal. You will learn curved machine piecing, flawless machine applique with turned edges (often confused for hand applique), accurate miters and perfect bindings. In addition to completing a darling sample quilt, you'll find yourself applying these techniques to every future quilt project you have.

Trish Stuart is an international teacher, has published 9 books, 2 full length “workshop in the home” DVD’s, and numerous package patterns, been a guest on 3 national television programs and has been a frequent contributor in national quilting magazines. She will teach students how to make the pattern 'Vanilla Jamaica'. This quilt brings the beginner up to the intermediate level without pain or fuss. Start by learning a half square triangle, progress to the angled border block, then with one more change create the interior diamond blocks. Oversize fusible applique is added for drama. There are three free videos available for viewing after the class so when finishing the quilt at home to help you remember the techniques learned in class.
