

SUPPLY LIST – Many of these items can be purchased from a dollar store

All supplies used for fabric dyeing should be kept away from children and food preparation utensils. You should have a separate set of supplies dedicated only to fabric dyeing. Do not store left over dye in your refrigerator.

Optimally you should be near a sink or alternatively a large bucket with water

- Gradation Dyeing Kit – Choose your own 3 color (The photo features FLOWER GARDEN)

- 5 Yds PFD cotton Fabric –

Other supplies – most can be found at the dollar store

- Water
- scissors
- Black Permanent Marker
- Liquid 1 or 2 Cup measuring cup
- 6 plastic spoons
- 30 zip lock sandwich baggies or 12 oz plastic cups
- Plastic bin if using baggies
- Measuring spoons (Tbsp and tsp) (If you can find a 1 ½ TBSP measuring spoon, that would be SUPER)
- Plastic tarp to cover work surface and floor
- 4 – quart size or large plastic bottles with lids (soda, seltzer, juice) The Simply Juice bottles have a nice flat bottom
- Disposable gloves
- 3 plastic cups (can be same cups as above)
- Paper Towels
- Funnel to fir the quart containers
- Condiment Bottles (3)**** (buy these from ProChem or a food supply store. The dollar store ones leak!)

Optional:

1-5 Fat quarters of cotton black& white fabric

Flat quart container to dye fabric left from gradation dyeing

White DMC floss or perle cotton
